How to Wash Dishes

Four Easy Steps for Washing Dishes

Step One - Pre-preparation

- Scrapping the plate is important it will make washing the dishes a lot easier, especially if they sit for half an hour before they are washed and dried.

Step Two - Preparation

- So the dishes have been scrapped and they are due to be washed. The next stage is preparation. This involves making sure all the cups are emptied before washing, any bowls have been rinsed, the sink is cleaned before dish washing, all the dishes are grouped and stacked together. Get the right amount of hot water and dish washing liquid is put in before starting.

Step Three - Washing the Dishes

- Now it is time for the dishes to be washed. These are done in groups; glasses, cups, silverware, dishes, and finally pots and pans. Grouping makes them easier to stack and quicker to get through. Each dish is washed with a dish cloth and then rinsed in hot water to make sure there is no dirt, if there's still a little dirt it needs to be washed and rinsed again. **You may have to change the water if necessary.**

Step Four - Post task

- The dishes have now all been washed and rinsed and stacked on the rack. Now you will dry the dishes and put them away. You will use a dry dish towel, not paper towels. Now it is time for sink cleanup. This involves cleaning any water and soap bubbles off the sink area, cleaning the sink out and rinsing out the sink.
